MORE INFORMATION:

- ❖ **Costs:** All general costs for transport, accommodation and meals in the hostel are covered. We will eat 2 times during the week in restaurants, here you will have to pay your own bill. Otherwise, you just need to bring pocket money for personal expenses.
- ❖ **Food:** Most of the time, our meals will be vegetarian/vegan, but we offer some meat as a side dish for those who really need it. When eating in restaurants, you can choose freely. Breakfast we will prepare for ourselves, so we will set up kitchen-teams. Other main meals will be mainly prepared for us, but we might help in arranging/cleaning the table. In the registration, we are asking about allergies and food preferences.
- ❖ **We will stay in our own seminar house.** The house has rooms for 2-4 people each. Bathrooms and toilets are shared. We have a kitchen in which we can prepare snacks, tea, etc. all the time.
- ❖ **There is only a very small shop in the village,** and other shops are in the next town. If you need any special items, please bring them along.

WHAT TO BRING ALONG:

- ❖ **Clothes for cold weather and snow.** We are expecting a wonderful winter setting with snow and ice, but it might also be rainy if the winter is mild. Bring enough clothes so you can change in case the onset of the cloth is wet.
- ❖ **Proper hiking shoes** for excursions that are solid and warm and protect against snow/water/wet weather.
- ❖ A small backpack/daypack for the excursions.
- ❖ **Enough warm clothes** also for the inside. The house is heated, but it is old and big, so it might not always be as warm as your living room at home.
- ❖ **House shoes/slippers** are important, so we keep wet hiking boots at the entrance.
- ❖ **Bring your own bedsheets and towels!** (You can also rent a set for 7 Euros for the entire stay).
