An international youth programme empowering young people to promote sustainable tourism, climate-friendly mobility and positive change through travel

- 👣 International youth programme
- 👣 Slovenia, Germany, Spain & Portugal
- 👣 Sustainable tourism & climate-friendly mobility
- 👣 Workshops, campaigns, seminars and volunteering
- 👣 More than 3,000 young people reached since 2022



Application & Selection Process

Due to limited funding, the number of participants per country will be restricted

- 👣 Each country will have a limited number of places (Portugal - 7, Spain - 7, Germany - 7, Slovenia - 9).
- 👣 Participants will be selected based on motivation, commitment and their interest in contributing to the TDFF programme.





Commitment & Pre-Meetings

- 👣 Attendance at mandatory online pre-meetings will be required.
- 👣 Active engagement before, during and after the seminar is expected.
- 👣 This is not just a trip – it is a responsibility and a contribution.

Green Travel Policy

All participants are expected to travel green (train or bus)

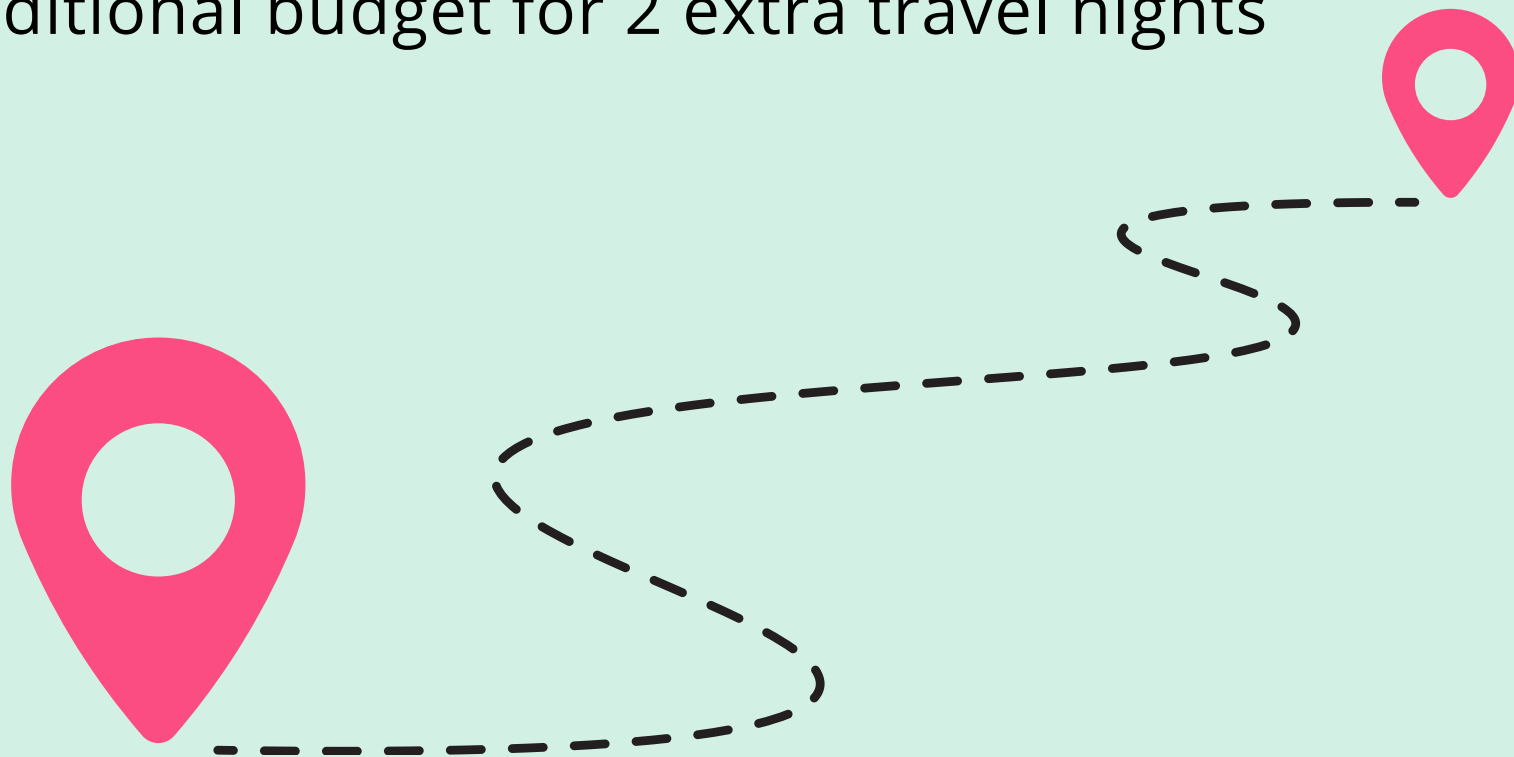
We want the journey itself to reflect the values of DTT.

What will we Develop?

During the seminar we will co-create:



- 👤 **TDFF Toolbox:** Short interactive methods for promoting sustainable tourism and climate-friendly mobility.
- 👤 **Simulation Games:** Interactive methods simulating real-life tourism conflicts and sustainability dilemmas.

What is the TDFF Toolbox



A practical promotional and educational tool

Short, interactive methods (10–20 minutes) that:

- 👤 Are facilitated by young people for young people,
- 👤 Work well at festivals, fairs and youth events,
- 👤 Enable a clear and accessible introduction to the TDFF programme and its activities.

It also support the promotion of:

- 👤 TDFF workshops
- 👤 The Climate-Friendly School Trips Campaign

What are TDFF Simulation Games



An experiential learning method for sustainable tourism

Interactive methods lasting 120–180 minutes that:

- 👤 Simulate real-life conflicts in an imaginary but realistic scenario
- 👤 Divide participants into stakeholder groups to negotiate solutions
- 👤 Develop strategy, alliances and communication skills

Why is this important for TDFF?

- 👤 Understanding sustainable tourism from multiple perspectives
- 👤 Experiencing democratic processes and compromise in practice
- 👤 Developing our own TDFF simulation game for high school & university
